Vision

A self reliant Dzongkhag co-existing in peace and harmony with enhanced socio-economic standards, rich natural resources and cultural heritage.

Mission

To enhance rural livelihood with good local governance in line with culture and environment.

Samdrup Jongkhar Dzongkhag is situated in the Southeastern corner of the country, sharing its southern and northern borders with the Indian states of Assam and Arunachal Pradesh respectively. To its west lies Pemagatshel Dzongkhag and to its north lies Trashigang Dzongkhag. It has a population of 40,766 (20,786 male and 19,980 female), with 4808 households and an area of 1877.94 sq. km, constituting around 4% of the country's total area.

Administratively, the Dzongkhag is divided into two Dungkhags; Jomotsangkha and Samdrupchoeling and sub-divided further into 11 Gewogs, Dewathang, Gomdar, Langchenphu, Lauri, Martshalla, Orong, Pemathang, Phuntshothang, Samrang, Serthi and Wangphu. There are 191 villages and 58 Chiwogs spreading across the 11 Gewogs. In addition, there is one Gyalyong Thromde and two Satellite towns.

The 28th Dzongkhag Education Conference was convened from 28th February to 4th March, 2019 at Minjiwoong Central School with the theme of "Enhancing professionalism and linking vision through sharing and learning good practices".

The objectives of the conference and reason for choosing venue at Minjiwoong CS were:

- 1. Provide platform for every school to host the DEC.
- 2. Provide participants with opportunity to familiarize with new places and exchange good practices between host and participating schools.
- 3. Acknowledge good works and initiatives of the schools under Jomotsangkha Drungkhag, to the inspiration of Principals participating from other schools.

The 5 days DEC embraced in essence, mass participation of Principals/representatives from all the schools under the Dzongkhag, in exchanging good practices of respective schools and linking to the overall vision of Education policy.

Result Analysis Presentation was made to keep abreast of the performance of the schools and to rive further improvement of academic results in both Home and Common Examinations.

The sessions included visit to schools. Presentations on IWP and Moderation Criteria, Policy, Action Plans, SSA, SIP, 12th Five-Year Plan, ECCD and SEN/NFE/Disaster Program, Life Skills Education Program, Commitment and Pledges were held on 3th March. SAY NO TO PLASTIC BAGS

Date: 16th March 2019

The Dzongkhag and Thromde Administration in collaboration with Samdrup Jongkhar Initiative (SJI), Royal Bhutan Police, volunteers from Samdrup Jongkhar Middle Secondary School and Jigme Namgyal Engineering College conducted a mass cleaning campaign and plastic ban advocacy on 16/3/19.

The volunteers were organized in groups with banners advocating on plastic ban, while they also collected waste materials across streets and along national highways between Dewathang to Samdrup Jongkhar town.



The use of filter water and methods of reusing were demonstrated during the campaign. ban on plastic was reinforced with effect from 1st April, 2019 to which whole public of Samdrup Jongkhar supported the initiative of the government.

"TB – One of the Public Health Issue" Date: 24th March 2019

Tuberculosis (TB) is an infectious disease caused by the bacillus called Mycobacterium tuberculosis. Tuberculosis being an age old disease, it still remains as one of the major public health problems globally, regionally and nationally. On 19th March, 2019 as a part of the aggressive fight against Tuberculosis/Multi Drug Resistance (TB/MDR) and ending TB by 2030, the World TB Day (WTD) was observed on the theme: "It's time to find, treat and End TB - Access services for screening, treatment and prevention".

Objectives:

- 1.To create mass awareness and educate staff and students about TB and MDR-TB
- 2.To identify missing cases of TB and initiate treatment
- 3.To seek support from relevant agencies and public to end TB.

In line with the above objectives, Dzongkhag Administration, Samdrup Jongkhar joined the global, regional and national community to observe this very important day at Orong Central School on 24/03/2019. Principal of Orong Central School welcomed all the participants gathered at the event and shared some of the pertinent issues related to health. After welcome address by the Principal, Health Coordinator of the school read out the Message from Her Excellency Lyonpo Dechen Wangmo, Minister of Health to the gathering. The Chief Guest, Hon'ble Dasho Dzongdag gave a remarkable talk on TB and other pertinent public health and social issues in the country, community and schools. Dr. Kezang Wangdi (GDMO) gave a detailed talk on topics related to TB. The program concluded with School health counselor Mr. Khenrab Yoesel proposing a wonderful vote of thanks to the participants.

Alcohol Harm Reduction in Samdrup Jongkhar Date: 5th May 2019

Alcohol is an old issue and still the talk of the town. Alcohol offering is a part of our culture and tradition. Besides harming our health, consuming alcohol is one of the factors for creating multiple social issues in society. As per the National Health Survey 2012, consumption of alcohol is high in eastern part of Bhutan, Pemagatshel Dzongkhag 53% and Samdrup Jongkhar with 28%. As per Kuensel, alcohol is a lucrative business. It contributes about Nu 1B to the government coffer, but the economic burden of alcohol on the country is four times its returns. The annual hospital treatment cost of treating alcohol liver disease in the country was estimated at Nu. 26 million in 2015.

As an approach, in line with the National Policy and Strategic Framework to reduce harmful use of





alcohol 2015-2020's guidelines, the Dzongkhag conducted awareness program in strategic areas. The

The Wait is finally Over for Tshothang Chiwog of Lauri Gewog Date: 2nd April 2019

Tshothang Chiwog under Lauri Gewog got its first elected Tshogpa this year. Tshothang is considered one of the smallest and remotest Chiwog under Samdrup Jongkhar Dzongkhag. For the last 13 years, the Chiwog remained without Tshogpa, owing to the unavailability of interested aspiring candidate. The Chiwog was then declared vacant Demkhong during the last Local Government Election, in 2016. However, the importance of the role of Tshogpa was realized when there are several Chiwog functionaries that has direct link with Gewog and Dzongkhag Administration.

Subsequently, the Chiwog requested to for election of Tshogpa, routing through Gewog and Dzong-khag administration to the Election Commission. The Election Commission, in pursuance of Sections 577, 579 & 197 of the Election Act of the Kingdom of Bhutan, 2008 called for election of Tshothang Chiwog Tshogpa on 2nd of April, 2019.

There were a total of 290 voters under the Chiwog, of which 122 were postal voters. On the poll day, the Returning Officer received 80 postal ballots which all counted "yes" vote for the candidate. At the polling station, a total of 53 voters came forward to vote on EVM in which 49 voted "yes" and 4 voted "no". As such, **Mr. Pema Darjay** was elected with 98% yes vote from the total of 175 voters. The total turnover was 60%.

Similarly, bye-election was also called in Narphoong Chiwog under Gomdar gewog after untimely demise of the incumbent. However, it had to be rescheduled with no nomination papers being filed within the notified date. The re-scheduled notification was called on 25th of May, 2019. All the election preparatory activities were carried out in strict compliance to the notification issued by the commission. There were 242 registered voters in the chiwog. During the poll day on the 20th of June, 2019, 107 exercised their franchise. Of 57 EVM voters 56 voted "Yes" and 1 "no" and similarly of 50 postal ballots received by the Office of Returning Officer 49 voted "yes" and 1 for "no". **Mr. Sherab Tenzin** was elected with 98% yes votes. The total turnout is at 44%.

"My Waste, My Responsibility"

Date: 2nd June 2019

Coinciding the Coronation Day of His Majesty the Fourth Druk Gyalpo on 2nd June 2019, the Zero Waste Hour "My Waste, My Responsibility" was graciously launched by Her Majesty The Gyaltsuen. It was initiated to instill a change towards proper waste management and practice sustainable consumption lifestyle leading towards safe, healthy and clean environment.

Driving towards that mission, the Dzongkhag Administration observed one hour (between 9:00 AM – 5:00 PM depending on the convenience) to clean our own surrounding areas on the **2nd day of every month**.

The Zero Waste Hour was observed on 2nd July, 2019 from 4pm to 5pm for one hour in Samdrup Jongkhar. The Dzongkhag staffs were organized into different groups for cleaning the surrounding areas in their respective places. There was not much of waste within our areas but had more of grass cutting works.

Freshwater Aquaculture farming (fish farming) for the youth members of Dorangthang, under Pemathang Gewog, Under Samdrup Choling Dungkhag(2019).

Under the command of HRH, the Gyeltshab on 31st July 2018, **Youths aquaculture development programme** at Dorangthang, Pemathang had been initiated integrated with piggery, through Dzongkhag fishery development services.

By location, the farm is located at the elephant movement zone, which frequents threat agriculture farming. In order to the wildlife threats, the Dzongkhag Livestock Sector designed trench type fish pond that can withstand elephant and other wildlife threats. Into 7 fishponds of 50 meter in length, 155000 numbers of six different species of fingerlings were impounded.

The expected income by taking 50 % of fish, with an average weight of 300-400 grams each, comes around 23 million tones of fresh fishes, every after 12 months of culture period production, which approximately comes to Nu 4.6m. culture management properly.

Through fish growth check up, the results were ascertained to be very effective and satisfactory till date. The group members were well motivated with lucrative income from fishery program business. With less investment against more income generating capacity, the aqua-farming was taken with keen interest and learning by the youths. And trench type fish pond with rectangular size is below:

It is a non-negotiable document of succinctly stated expectations around the mutual responsibilities of the central office, the school and the board in relation to the enactment and support of greater autonomy.

The DPA underpins the important role played by the board in school governance and provides IPS communities with confidence that the Department will continue to provide the school with resources and support, clearly stated expectations around the exercise of more autonomy to improve outcomes for young people and the management of human and financial resources, assurance that these outcomes will be monitored and reported and guidance about the key responsibilities of the principal and the school board.

Outreach Health-care Service Program (Ultrasound services)

Date: 24th November 2019

Dzongkhag health sector, in coordination with S/Jongkhar hospital, outreach health-care service program (Ultrasound services) has been initiated for the people of five Gewogs since this services are not available in their health centers such as Phuntshothang, Martshalla, Gomdar, Orong and Wangphu Gewogs. Currently people have to travel all the way to Samdrup Jongkhar or Dewathang hospital to avail ultrasound services. Especially, pregnant women are most affected due to lack of such services in their Gewogs/health centers. Due to benefit of this program for the people, this story is also been covered by Bhutan Broadcasting Service (BBS) on 24th Nov. 2019 (After 8:00 PM News hour). This program is being supported through Dzongkhag Health sector's approved annual budget (Capital) for conducting mobile health camp.

Objective: To improve quality and accessibility of health care services for the people of far-flung areas where ultrasound services are not readily available at their nearest health facility. Since the portable ultrasound machine is not available in the district, it was requested and borrowed from Trashigang hospital just for this program. **Follow-up and monitoring:** All the cases detected were provided appropriate health education for self management or further advice on control and prevention aspects.

Severe cases were either referred to hospital for tertiary care while some are advised to repeat the investigation at Samdrup Jongkhar hospital to monitor their health conditions. Ultrasound technician will be reviewing and monitoring those patients who are recorded as abnormal findings.

It is proposed that in the first year of its operation, the project will produce 30 MT of ginger oil and its capacity utilization will increase by 5% annually. The project's final product will be sold in the regional and international markets besides supplying to the local food industries, high-end hotels. The project is ideally located at Samdrup Jongkhar Thromde under LAP-IV (3 Kilo) in Samdrup Jongkhar.

The project which is first of its kind in Bhutan aims at achieving the following key objectives:

- To add value to the locally grown ginger mainly for exports.
- To create a sustainable source of income generation opportunities for farmers and rural entrepreneurs.
- •To create employment avenues for job seekers and farmers.
- •To earn convertible currencies such as INR, Euro, US\$, etc. by exporting the value added products.

The Dzongkhag Agriculture Sector is closely working with BGP to create market link between farmers and buyer (BGP) by forming groups in ginger growing areas. Moreover, with fund support from CARLEP project, BGP will soon benefits with Raw Ginger Processing Machines worth of million.
